



VALUATION CONSIGNMENT AND DECLARATION FORM

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Please read the following very carefully

Make a brief note describing each item in the inventory part of this form then place each one in a small plastic bag.

Items such as earrings and pendants with light chains count as ONE item and so go together.

Place all the bags in the larger bag with the completed form. There is no need to include this page or the notes regarding data protection – keep these for your reference.

If you intend to post your property be sure to check your insurance for outside and sending risk cover.

The Royal Mail Special Delivery service should be used to send valuable items

Do not include boxes or cases in the consignment.

If you are coming to the office A receipt will be given to you for your property.

If it is not possible to undertake valuations while you wait in the office you will be invited to return later in the day or to arrange another date to pick up your property, depending on the number of items and the complexity of the work required.

When the items are picked up the reverse process will take place with your items being returned in plastic bags.

Special provisions

- ◆ When you come to the office be prepared to park off-site as on-site parking is limited. If you have special needs please ask at reception.
- ◆ If you find the reception area un-occupied, please take a seat in the lounge.
- ◆ If you have exhibited cold-like symptoms or have come into contact with someone who has within the last fourteen days please cancel your appointment and re-book, allowing at least another fourteen days.
- ◆ All gem set jewellery will be cleaned, however, there are sensitive gemstones which cannot be effectively cleaned without potential damage. Watches including metal bracelets cannot be deep cleaned except by a jewellery or watch technician. You are advised to clean your jewellery before and after use. We can advise on the best way to do this.

Customer privacy notice (please keep this sheet)

When you leave your items for valuation you are asked to sign the declaration of consent form. Your consent is required to enable us to collect and store your personal data in line with current Data Protection legislation.

Information we collect

- ◆ We collect personal data you provide to us. This includes information you give when communicating with us such as your name, email address, home address & telephone number. We also ask for details regarding the property you want to have valued such as stone reports, sales receipts, previous valuations etc.
- ◆ Data is also created by your purchase of a valuation report, including data relating to the items and their value.
- ◆ You are asked to read and sign this form on which you provide some personal data.


Data Protection Policy

◆ Once it reaches the valuer your data will be kept in a secure digital form, encrypted, and protected by passwords known only to the valuer. Any backup will also be encrypted and stored in a safe when not in use. **How long data is stored**

- ◆ The valuer will retain a copy of your valuation for as long as may be required to fulfil the original purpose for which the data was collected. Since you may need to refer to this data in the future when your own copy might not be available, we recommend a period of seven years. In the event the valuer ceases to trade the data will be permanently removed from the storage medium. ◆ Personal data can be removed or modified at your request at any time.

Disclosing and Sharing of Data

- ◆ The valuer will not sell your information to anyone.
- ◆ The valuer will not pass your data on to any third party without your permission, except if compelled to do so by law.
- ◆ The valuer affirms that data supplied to him will not be used for any other purpose, other than to record, file and recover reports for your own use and not to market any other service to you.
